Visit to Alcazaba



In the centre of Malaga the majestic Arabic fortress Alcazaba rises high on a hill. The millennial old fortification is surrounded by rough stone walls but on the inside, a magical palace hides with luxurious gardens, fountains and art work. Picasso's birthplace and museum

Paella Night

Surf

El Chorro

Natural Parks



The Natural Parks of *Montes de Malaga*, *Sierra de las Nieves* and *Sierra de la Almijara* among others, are the perfect places to immerse yourself in nature and enjoy the flora, fauna and active tourism activities throughout the year.

La Concepción

Historical - Botanical Gardens



La Concepcion Historical-Botanical Gardens belongs to the City of Malaga Municipal Botanical Trust created in 1855. They are home to an exquisite open-air collection of tropical and subtropical flora. Plant species from Europe, America, Asia, Africa and Oceania are all on show here.

Officially declared historical-artistic gardens in 1943, they are also recognised as an Item of Cultural Interest.

Day trip to Seville



The Andalusian capital prides itself with several architectural and historical monuments of importance. The 1929 Iberian exhibition monument Plaza de España, the cathedral, Europe's oldest still functioning royal palace and Christopher Columbus grave are some of the things that make Seville an exquisite destination.

Weekend in Morocco



Just across the stretch of Gibraltar lies the African continent. By crossing the water you leave Europe behind and enter the fascinating Arabic country, Morocco. The 2.5 days long trip takes you to the ancient cities of Tetuan and Tangier as well as the world heritage mountain village Chef-Chaouen. Local guides let you immerse in the exotic Moroccan culture.

This excursion is not supervised by EF leaders. We require parental consent for underage students.

Olive oil tasting



Olive oil is one of the Spanish gastronomy treasures. Understanding and knowing how to differentiate them and their qualities is a precious skill that we offer, so the students can leave Spain with a full understanding of the Spanish gastronomy and its culture.

Feria de Málaga

15 AUGUST



During one week in August, people from Malaga wear the typical Flamenco dress and fill the streets with music and dance. Locals and visitors dance together, eat and drink sweet wine.

Feria of Malaga starts with a magnificent firework show at the port on a Friday night and terminates nine days later.

We organise a school visit to the Feria and teach you how to dance Sevillanas!

Noche de Reyes

The three wizard kings' parade



Following the Catholic tradition, on the 5th January at night, three magic kings arrive to Malaga and cross the city offering candies to adults and children. We will take students to the parade and challenge them: How many candies are they able to catch?

During the night, the magic kings mounted on their camels, will visit every house and deposit presents.

Joint trips with EF Madrid / EF Barcelona



3-4 times a year we organize activities together with EF Madrid and EF Barcelona to different cities in Spain so we make a mega event out of our trip and the students have the opportunity to meet students who are learning Spanish from other schools. *Our most visited places are **Valencia, Madrid and Granada.***
