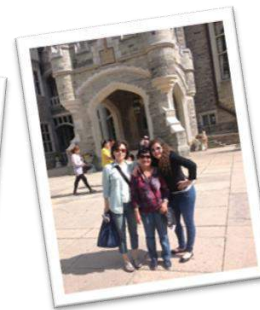
# Accommodation
